# Kelleway wins premier's award

Keith Kelleway of the Ridge Canoe and Kayak Club has been named as B.C.'s male paddler of the year and received the premier's athletic award at the ceremony on Thursday in Vancouver.

The Thomas Haney secondary senior was recently named to the Canadian junior team, and spent the summer competing in events as far flung as Bochum, Germany, and Moscow, where he and his K-4 crew won a bronze medal in the 200-metre knock-out.

"Those larger international competitions were challenging and exciting," said Kelleway, "I really enjoyed the travel to new venues, with different food and language challenges. But all of the athletes there loved competing."

At the Western Canada Summer Games, Kelleway brought home 10 medals from the 10 events he was entered. He will be repre-

senting Team B.C. at the Canada Games in Prince Edward Island in August, as well at the Canadian National Championships in Sherbrooke, Quebec in early September.
