In return for the funding assistance provided all athletes must:

- Sign an Athlete Code of Conduct
- Agree to fulfill all training and competition commitments,
- Make themselves available to TEAM BC/WESTERN CANADA SUMMER GAMES/CANADA SUMMER GAMES selection,
- Represent a CKC registered BC club at ALL club events in the upcoming season
- Contribute to athlete and coaching development programs run by CanoeKayak BC within BC
- Permit the unrestricted use of my name, list of sport accomplishments and BC AAP generated images for the purpose of recognition by the Government of BC officials and the media as they pertain to the BC Athlete Assistance Program.
