

**Let CanoeKayak BC bring our National CanoeKids  
Water Safety and Learn to Paddle Program to  
your Community this summer!**



**WHAT IS IT?**

One week day camp program led by qualified National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Community Coach certified instructors who while focusing on long term athlete development principles will provide a fun and safe introduction to water safety and racing canoes and kayaks.

All equipment (boats, paddles, life jackets) and instructors are provided.

**WHO IS IT FOR?**

Individuals aged 9 – 14 years of age of all abilities are welcome. Interested participants may look to qualifying for the 2012 BC Summer Games in Surrey. Participants should be comfortable in and around the water but will also be required to wear a life jacket at all times. PaddleALL athletes are welcome to participate but may be asked to bring a buddy depending on their level of ability.

**COST?**

- \$95/person/session (participants registering for both sessions may discount the price by \$20)
- Morning Session - 9am – 12 noon Monday through Thursday/Friday 9am – 1pm
- Afternoon Session – 1pm – 4pm Monday through Thursday/Friday 9am – 1pm
- A maximum of 16 participants may register for each session (morning or afternoon)
- Before/after camp care can be provided if pre-arranged at a cost of \$10/hour/person

**WHAT DO YOU (THE COMMUNITY) NEED TO PROVIDE?**

- Advertising
- Registration (or direct to our website to register and pay)
- Venue (with washrooms and preferably a covered area in the event of inclement weather)
- A safe and accessible water site with either dock or beach access

**WHAT DO YOU (THE COMMUNITY) GET?**

- The opportunity to host a CanoeKids instructor's course in your community the week prior to your camp week
- Mentorship opportunities for recently graduated CanoeKids Instructors so that they gain experience and can continue to deliver programs in your community
- CanoeKayak BC has a liability insurance policy with a coverage of \$5,000,000
- ALL instructors are NCCP certified and have completed Criminal Record Checks
- Recreation opportunities without using costly recreation facilities
- Community members with water safety skills
- 20% of the total registration revenue will remain with the host community in exchange for advertising/registration being provided
