



POSITION: COACH – JUNIOR SPRINT PROGRAM - FLAT WATER

STATUS: Part time position

SALARY: \$14.50 per hour (paid bi-weekly) in accordance with BC Labour Standards and Canada Revenue Agency and also in accordance with Canada Summer Jobs Grant.

The Pitt Meadows Paddling Club is situated on the Alouette River just north of the City of Pitt Meadows at 14411 Harris Road. The club has available to its members a variety of watercraft including Dragon Boats, Outriggers, Canoes, Kayaks, SUPs and Sprint Canoes as well as a variety of other boats. The club has approximately 120 members and runs training programs throughout the year. Outriggers go all year round. Summer Camps are run through the summer months. School and Community groups also participate in the paddling experience along with a Paddle All Program.

JOB SUMMARY:

The Coach will be responsible for the Junior Sprint paddlers. This position will entail training sessions – both on and off the water, as well as attending regattas and competitions locally. The Coach will abide by the Coaches Code of Conduct and will need to respect the Club's policies regarding fair play and equity.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Design training programs for a junior sprint flat water paddlers
- Run all training sessions both on and off the water
- Be responsible for registration and entries for all regattas/competitions as well as collecting applicable fees
- Help to organize transportation of equipment and supplies for each regatta/competition
- Maintain the daily operation, safety, security, order and cleanliness of the site
- Report regularly to the guardians/paddlers on the progress of the paddler and what needs to happen to further enhance their position
- Report regularly to the Board of the PMPC on the progress of the sprint program
