## CANOEKAYAK BC TRAVEL GRANT POLICY - SPRINT

CanoeKayak BC is thankful to the Ministry of Healthy Living and Sport and the Community Access Gaming Grants for allowing us to provide support to those members living outside the event hosting region.

During the 2011 season CanoeKayak BC will provide a travel subsidy to registered competitive athletes attending the following events:

- BC Long Distance Championships (Pitt Meadows)
- \*\*\*BC School Dragonboat Championships (Burnaby)
- Team BC Trials (Kamloops)
- Team BC Training Camps (Fort Langley)
- BC Championships (Burnaby)
- BC Bantam/Novice Championships (Nanaimo)
- 'In Province' Spring Training Camp

Participants travelling a distance of over 100 km (round trip) or that involve ferry travel, are eligible to apply.

Applications must be submitted to the CanoeKayak BC office within 30 days of the completion of the event.

\*\*\*Bus travel will be arranged by the CanoeKayak BC office in lieu of individual applications. Eligible clubs must indicate their interest a minimum of 2 weeks in advance of the event. Athletes attending only this event are not required to have a 'competitive' membership however they must be a registered member of a member club.
