



## Policies and Procedures - Athletes

External Sport Credits - Sprint	November 2014	

### 1.0 Introduction

Competitive sprint members of CKBC are eligible for the following external sport credits. This credit DOES NOT replace the Physical Education credit but rather supplements the student's graduation portfolio. Letters should be handed to high school counselors immediately upon receipt. Students will receive credit for each course only once.

### 2.0 Athlete Programs

#### 2.1 Athlete 10 - Provincial

- a) Athletes receiving credit for this program will have been members of a BC Summer Games Team OR
- b) Compete at the BC Championships in a U17 class or higher and meet the following criteria
  - (i) Top 5 in a singles event OR
  - (ii) Top 3 in a doubles event OR
  - (iii) Winner of a 4's eventAND
- c) Be coached by a coach at a minimum level of NCCP Entry Level Competitive Coach or NCCP Level 2

#### 2.2 Athlete 11 - Interprovincial

- a) Athletes receiving credit for this program will:
  - (i) Be a member of Team BC – Western Canada Games Team OR
  - (ii) Receive funding from the BC Athlete Assistance Program OR
  - (iii) Compete at the Regina Canada Day Regatta or the Western Canadian Championships in a U17 class or higher and meet the following criteria:
    - Make the final in a singles event
    - Finish in the top 5 in a doubles event
    - Finish in the top 3 of a 4's eventAND
- b) Be coached by a coach at a minimum level of NCCP Introduction to Competition or NCCP Level 2

#### 2.3 Athlete 12 – National

- a) Athletes receiving credit for this program will:
  - (i) Be a member of Team BC – Canada Summer Games Team OR
  - (ii) Receive funding from the Sport Canada Athlete Assistance Program OR
  - (iii) Compete at the Canadian National Championships in a U17 class or higherAND
- b) Be coached by a coach at a minimum level of NCCP Competition Development or NCCP Level 3

CKBC will issue validation letters for meeting other criteria stated upon receipt of training diaries and annual training plans..
