Sport on the Move Travel Assistance Program Policy - Sprint	November 2014	May 30, 2019

### 1.0 Introduction

CKBC is thankful to the Ministry of Healthy Living and Sport and the Community Access Gaming Grants for allowing us to provide support to those members living outside the event-hosting region.

For the 2014 season CKBC will provide a travel subsidy to registered competitive athletes and one certified coach per club attending the following events:

- a) BC Long Distance Championships
- b) \*\*\*BC School Dragonboat Championships
- c) Team BC Trials
- d) Team BC Training Camps (including Fitdex)
- e) BC Championships
- f) BC U15/Novice Championships

Participants travelling a distance of over 100 km (round trip) or that involve ferry travel, are eligible.

\*\*\*Bus travel will be arranged by the CKBC office in lieu of individual applications. Eligible clubs must indicate their interest a minimum of 2 weeks in advance of the event. Athletes attending only this event are not required to have a 'competitive' membership however they must be a registered member of a member club

### 2.0 Coach Eligibility

Certified coaches attending the above events with athletes they coach on a regular basis are eligible for travel assistance provided they have participated in a minimum of one professional development opportunity in the last 12-month period AND have contributed to and supported a minimum of one provincial program delivery in the last 6 months.

### 3.0 Applications

Applications must be submitted to the CKBC office within 30 days of the completion of the event.
